# UPDATE JANUARY 2022

## Emergency Preparedness

The hazards that individuals might face will vary but it is important that residents of all communities recognize the ones which could be faced in order to adequately prepare for an emergency. In our Fraser Valley Regional District, the three natural hazards likely to be faced are floods, landslides and wildfires.

Even though they can happen at any time, flooding events usually occur in the spring and the fall. Landslides are of special concern to any residential developments situated at the base or near the side of a steep slope. Waterways can also influence a slide so residents must be aware of those changes. Wildfires usually occur in the dry summer months and can threaten homes, livelihoods, livestock, businesses and infrastructure.

Residents in our area have faced all three hazards in the past year. Extreme weather events resulted in June's catastrophic fire that swept through Lytton, November's flooding in North Bend, in repeated highway closures, long periods without power, downed landline and cell services and severe and unprecedented infrastructural damage in every direction. Currently, we are facing potential landslide and avalanche hazards due to the recent winter storm and we will possibly need to contend with road closures throughout the rest of the winter season.

Each household is unique and many have well-stocked pantries and generators to see them through, while others might not. However, EVERYONE should have these very **basic** items on hand to last at LEAST 72 hours should an emergency occur. Due to our remote location, it is recommended to increase these amounts to last 5-7 days.

- ◇ 4 litres of water per person per day
- ◇ Supply of non-perishable foods
- ◇ First Aid Kit and personal medications
- ◇ Hand crank flashlight or have extra batteries
- ◇ Cell phone with extra power supply or a solar charger
- ◇ Paper towels, toilet paper, person hygiene products
- ◇ Garbage bags, moist towelettes, plastic ties
- ◇ Board games, cards, books, to help pass the time
- ◇ Extra water and foods for pets
